Terms and Conditions

1. The crèche has been set up to enable parents to enjoy the conference and for the children to interact and meet others with albinism. It is not a professional child care centre, however we have done all in our power to make it safe and enjoyable for the children.
2. The crèche is staffed by a combination of volunteers and trained paid workers. We will always endeavor to use people who have had working with children and police checks.

3. The crèche will be in an adjoining room.
4. Please fill out one form per child attending.
5. Please supply an individual photo of all children who will be in the crèche for identification purposes during the day and on child pickup; we also ask that parents bring photo ID and be prepared to sign the children out so that we may verify your signature & protect your children.
6. We will be supplying morning and afternoon tea, but ask that the parents pick the children up for lunch in the main room. There will be no beds in the crèche.
7. Please bring a drink bottle, or bottle with water or juice clearly named. The crèche doesn't have a fridge, so we can't store milk. If needed, milk will need to be given by parents during the lunch break.
8. Please do not bring any peanuts or seafood products to the crèche as some children may have allergies.
9. Although your child's safety is a priority, we take no responsibility if accidents happen between children. We are not liable for such incidences or injuries.
10. If your child is crying or inconsolable, we will do all we can to settle them, however if we need to, we will contact you at the conference by phone or PA. Please keep your phone on silent in case.
11. If your child has a life threatening allergy to a common food or product we will not be able to accept them in the crèche. We would hate for anything to happen to them in our care.
12. Please don't bring any personal items such as toys to the crèche. If a child has a sentimental comfort item then please mark it with their name. We will do our best to find it at the end of the day but take no responsibility if it goes missing. If they have a dummy then please attach it with a dummy chain to their clothing & include a cover.
13. Please bring all your child's nappies and wipes clearly named.
14. Please put all your child's items in a bag clearly named.
15. Breastfeeding mothers are welcome to come and feed as needed.
